

## Care Packages 2016 How your Group/Church help?

**Mission:** To express the love of Christ to internationals attending IFI Bible Discussion Groups by giving a small shoebox full of items to encourage them as they study/work in the U.S.

**The Idea:** This project is aimed to involve more people in the work of reaching internationals, similar to Operation Christmas Child.

## What items are in the care packages?

- Your church **purchases and packages the** items for each box:
  - 0 1 note of encouragement with a verse from the Bible
  - 0 1 small purse size Travel Tissue
  - 0 1 travel-size Hand Sanitizer
  - 0 1 travel-size Hand Lotion
  - 0 1 pair of warm socks or a scarf (gender neutral)
  - 0 1 individually wrapped bag of unpopped microwave popcorn
  - 0 1 pre-packaged snack size bag of nuts or trail mix (1 2 oz. size)
  - 0 1 package of ramen noodles
  - 0 2 tea bags or packets of hot chocolate
  - 0 1 gift card in the amount of \$5 (Suggestions: Target, Panera Bread, AMC Theater)
  - 0 1 picture of the person/family or group giving the care package *(optional)*

## How can Groups help? Take responsibility for gathering and packaging items in shoeboxes. Please let us know how many boxes you can fill.

- Ask folks to purchase items (see above list) to be put in the boxes
- Have a packaging party with your group and pray for the recipients *prayer prompts provided by IFI*
- Print and place labels on each box document for printing labels provided by IFI
- Return filled boxes to the IFI office or make arrangements with IFI to visit a Bible discussion group to personally give the care packages to internationals.

- Great way to involve more people in IFI work
- Help to bring about awareness of IFI and recruit more volunteers
- Partner with and support Bible discussion leaders in fulfilling the mission of reaching internationals with God's love.
